• What does revision mean?

Revision is usually done in the build up to exams. In order to get the best results in your exams you must revise.

Revision can be done in a number of ways and it is important that you find out how you revise the best.

• How do you start to revise?

In order to revise you need to make sure that you have all of the information that you need. You also need to make sure that have put aside the right amount of time to revise and that you have somewhere to revise without anything to distract you.

Do I know where and when I am going to revise?






Why do you need to revise?
