I'm just so proud of her! Her resilience to this transition, and this new building is just amazing xx

To hear my son's progress at his annual review meeting and to see how happy he is coming out of school has been amazing. He struggled all through primary school and I was so scared of him coming here, but he has never been happier and feels like he belongs.

As I passed your school today I noticed in the playground a young lad doing his little run up and down autism thing in his own little world on his own just like my son does and I felt quite emotional as my son had trouble with schooling.

Thank you for your time and efforts with those with SEN, it is much appreciated.

We are so very grateful for everything you have done for both our boys. I have to say in all the schools we have dealt with, you shine above and beyond the rest (I still don't know if you ever sleep? Lol).
