PE kit policy

Dear Parent / Carer


We are writing to inform you that we have been fortunate enough to receive funding for a new PE uniform. If your son or daughter does not already have a Fullhurst logo PE top, we will ensure that they receive one before the end of September. Students will sign a form to say they have received their top and will also write their names in it to stop them from going missing.

Students need to bring their own **black tracksuit bottoms and / or shorts** for PE lessons. Hoodies are not permitted, however with winter fast approaching, we recommend that students also have a warmer jumper or jacket which is suitable for physical activity.

We have a strict policy regarding PE kit and we feel that this new investment in PE tops will cut down on the number of students failing to bring PE kit for their lessons. PE kit is a compulsory requirement for all practical lessons and therefore failure to bring kit, without a genuine note and no alternative change of clothes, will result in a half hour detention after college on the day the PE kit has been forgotten. If your son / daughter is unable to participate in PE for a sustained period of time due to medical reasons, we do ask that a medical note is provided. Your son / daughter is still required to bring their PE kit with them as they can take on coaching and observation roles within the lesson.

We would appreciate your support in ensuring that the PE kit policy is adhered to, so together we can continue to maintain high standards throughout Fullhurst Community College.
