Dear Parents / Carers,

I am writing to you following my letter yesterday regarding our plans for some face-to-face support for Year 10 students, in accordance with the government's guidance for secondary schools.

As mentioned yesterday our Governing Body have been reviewing our risk assessment and proposed plans for Year 10 students and has **now approved these plans**. Therefore, next week, we will be welcoming back Year 10 students whose parents / carers have told ourselves they wish to attend.

As I have explained in previous letters, our priority is the safety of staff and students at Fullhurst. Therefore, it is essential all students follow our expectations and new way of working at school.

To help understand these expectations, explained in our guide sent out last week, please take some time to look at the following information:

Additionally, upon arrival to school next week we will be revisiting the presentation by myself, so that everyone is clear of the expectations and new ways of working at school.

We cannot compromise on these expectations, as they have been put in place to ensure the safety of students and staff at school and therefore your support in reinforcing these with your son or daughter would be appreciated.

Some key points, included in this guidance, to highlight are:

- Students are only to attend once we have contacted home and only on the day, they have been told to attend on.
- Students are **not** to attend if:
 - They have symptoms of COVID 19 (persistent cough, high temperature, loss or change to sense of smell or taste) or have a positive viral test result for COVID 19.
 - They are living with a person self-isolating and should not attend for 14 days as per Government guidance.
 - They are Extremely Clinically Vulnerable or lives with a person that is Extremely Clinically Vulnerable.
 - Additionally, any student that is Clinically Vulnerable (but not extremely clinically vulnerable), in line with government guidance, parents should follow medical advice if their child is in this category and therefore almost certainly should **not** attend.
 - Leicester City Council guidance is that whilst persons from the *Black, Asian & Minority Ethnic (BAME) community* are not officially categorised within the Clinically Vulnerable Group, due to their greater statistical likelihood of contracting the virus, it is recommended that they be considered for control purposes to be within this group.
- All students must follow social distancing guidance and remain 2 metres from others.
- All students must tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus.
- All students must where possible follow the guidance on sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it') and avoiding touching their mouth, nose and eyes with hands.
- Students will only attend from 9-1.00pm, as such, there will be no lunch served and break will be in the classrooms.
- As no food will be served and our water fountains have been turned off. Therefore, students should bring a drink and if they wish a snack to school.
